Maths

For every 4 days that Jack works, he has 3 days off. How many days off does he have in 10 weeks?

In a sponsored swim, Jemba did breast stroke for 200 m out of every 500 m. If he swam 3.5 km altogether, how much of that was breast stroke?

Ben is training for a marathon. For every 15 minutes he runs, he walks for 5 minutes. For how long does he walk during 3 hours of training?

For every 25 minutes of exercise in the gym, Ceri has 5 minutes rest. If she spends 2 hours in the gym in total, for how many minutes is she exercising?

Hakir's mother has told him that for every hour he plays on the computer he must spend 20 minutes on household jobs.

During one week he spends $5\frac{1}{2}$ hours playing on the computer.

How long does he do household jobs for?

Mark is training for a 5000 m race by sprinting and walking.

For every 30 m he sprints, Mark walks for 10 m.

How many metres does he walk in a total distance of 120 m?

TV addict Jake watches television for approximately 3 hours every day. What proportion of a day does Jake spend watching television?
